



must limit the diamond losers to only two. This might look difficult at first glance. But actually, there is no way you can lose more than 2 diamonds. You are only missing the ♦K and ♦Q; you have the ♦AJ109.

Start by winning the second spade with a heart ruff in your hand and lead up to the ♥KQ. Then come back to your ♣K to pull the last trump. Now you can finesse the ♦10. This loses to East's ♦J. Win the return and play the ♦A and another diamond. West will take his ♦K but the last diamond is yours.
